Murray & Co are looking for a student who combines intellectual ability with a genuine interest and awareness of investment banking activity in Australasia. The successful applicant will have a strong academic record and will be a self-starter with a desire to learn from and be involved in the current transactions of the firm.

The Application and Selection Process

Applicants should submit the following information to careers@murrays.co.nz, referencing "Work Placement" in the subject header, no later than **26th of June 2015**:

- A brief cover letter addressed to Murray & Company Limited
- A statement of no more than 1,000 words outlining:
 1. your career aspirations and the key qualities that make you a good candidate for this work experience; and
 2. a recent corporate finance transaction in the media that you found interesting and why (e.g. Merger & Acquisition, take-over, equity/debt/hybrid offering)
- An original or certified true copy of your academic record

All candidates will receive acknowledgement of their application, and some will be required for interview shortly after the closing date.

Selection will be based principally upon academic achievement, personal attributes and the candidate's interest in a career in the finance industry.

Murray & Co will make the final decision as to which student shall be awarded the internship.
